WHEREAS, the Portland Office of Emergency Management no longer utilizes volunteers as part of its staff of workers.

WHEREAS, the Portland Office of Emergency Management desires to have the City file the appropriate documents with the Department of Consumer and Business Services that the City ceases to elect Workers' Compensation coverage for volunteers of the Portland Office of Emergency Management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Portland:

1. That the Council declares Resolution No. 34841 officially rescinded effective on the date this resolution is approved by City Council.
2. That the Office of Management and Finance/Risk Management is directed to file appropriate documents that inform the Department of Consumer and Business Services of the City's election not to cover volunteers of the Portland Office of Emergency Management under the Workers' Compensation laws of the State of Oregon.


